TEACHERS: STUDENT RATIO, SALARIES & DISTRICT PERFORMANCE



- THE STUDENT-TO-TEACHER RATIO IN HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS REMAINS SLIGHTLY HIGHER THAN THE COUNTY MEDIAN. HOLMDEL 10:1, COUNTY 9.6:1
- WHILE THE MEDIAN TEACHER SALARY IN HOLMDEL IS APPROXIMATELY \$6,000 HIGHER THAN THE COUNTY MEDIAN. IT IS IMPORTANT TO NOTE THAT HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS SIGNIFICANTLY OUTPERFORMS COUNTY MEDIANS IN MATH AND ELA STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT: MATH PROFICIENCY: 24 PERCENTAGE POINTS HIGHER THAN THE COUNTY MEDIAN (2023–24 SCHOOL YEAR) ELA PROFICIENCY: 17 PERCENTAGE POINTS HIGHER THAN THE COUNTY MEDIAN (2023–24 SCHOOL YEAR)
- ADDITIONALLY, THE ONGOING TEACHER SHORTAGE HAS CREATED A "SELLER'S" MARKET IN EDUCATION, FURTHER EMPHASIZING THE NEED FOR COMPETITIVE COMPENSATION TO ATTRACT AND RETAIN HIGH-QUALITY EDUCATORS

STUDENT/TEACHER RATIO, MEDIAN SALARY, PERFORMANCE: COUNTY AVERAGES

NEGOTIATED CONTRACTS AND SALARIES



- A COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF THE TEACHER CONTRACT SETTLEMENT RATES IN HOLMDEL WITH THE COUNTY AND STATE AVERAGES OVER THE LAST 14 YEARS WAS PERFORMED FOR 2011-2025.
- IN 10 OF THE 14 YEARS THE % SALARY INCREASES WERE BELOW BOTH THE COUNTY AND STATE AVERAGE.
- IN TWO OF THE YEARS, THE % SALARY INCREASE WAS ABOVE THE COUNTY AVERAGE BUT BELOW THE STATE AVERAGE.
- IN ONLY TWO OF THE YEARS WERE THE % SALARY INCREASE SLIGHTLY HIGHER THAN BOTH THE COUNTY AND STATE AVERAGE

ADMINISTRATIVE HEADCOUNT/STAFFING



HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS ARE ADMINISTRATIVELY TOP-HEAVY DATA: FALSE

- HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS' RATIO OF STUDENTS TO ADMINISTRATORS IS **144.3** COMPARED TO THE COUNTY MEDIAN OF **116.5**.
- THE MEDIAN ADMINISTRATOR SALARY IN HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS IS \$134,217 COMPARED TO THE COUNTY MEDIAN OF \$138,816.
- THE RATIO OF FACULTY TO ADMINISTRATORS IN HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS IS **16.5**, COMPARED TO THE COUNTY MEDIAN OF **13.7**.
- WHEN CONTROLLING FOR DISTRICT SIZE, HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS' TOTAL ADMINISTRATIVE COST PER STUDENT IS \$1,521,
 - COMPARED TO THE COUNTY MEDIAN OF \$2,148.

ADMINISTRATIVE HEADCOUNT/STAFFING



• ADMINISTRATOR SALARIES & BENEFITS, **HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS'** COST PER STUDENT IS **\$1,351**, compared to the county median of **\$1,667**.

• ADDITIONALLY, **HOLMDEL TOWNSHIP SCHOOLS** OUTPERFORMED THE DISTRICT MEDIAN IN **MATH PROFICIENCY** BY **24 PERCENTAGE POINTS** AND IN **ELA PROFICIENCY** BY **17 PERCENTAGE POINTS** FOR THE **2023–24** SCHOOL YEAR.

MCVSD ENROLLMENT



- IN REVIEWING MCVSD ENROLLMENT BETWEEN THE 2021–22 AND 2024–25 SCHOOL YEARS, ENROLLMENT HAS RANGED FROM 102 STUDENTS TO A PEAK OF 119 STUDENTS IN 2022–23, WITH 112 STUDENTS ENROLLED IN 2024–25.
- MOST DISTRICTS ENROLL TWO STUDENTS PER DISTRICT , WHEREAS OVER 20 STUDENTS PER YEAR FROM
 HOLMDEL ARE ADMITTED. THE MAJORITY OF THESE STUDENTS ATTEND EITHER BIOTECHNOLOGY HIGH
 SCHOOL OR HIGH TECHNOLOGY HIGH SCHOOL .
- UNDER THE CORRESPONDING STATUTE NJSA 18A:54-20.1, THERE IS NO LIMIT TO THE NUMBER OF STUDENTS
 WHO CAN BE ACCEPTED. THE SCHOOL DISTRICT RECEIVES NO FINANCIAL SUPPORT
 FROM THE COUNTY OR
 STATE FOR TUITION, WHICH IS APPROXIMATELY \$7,000 PER PUPIL.
- DESPITE OFFERING AN EXCEPTIONAL BREADTH AND DEPTH OF HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAMMING AND RIGOR
 AS WELL AS INCREASING EFFORTS THROUGH ANNUAL OPEN HOUSES AND HANDS-ON SUPPORT
 FOR
 PROSPECTIVE VOCATIONAL SCHOOL ATTENDEES, ANNUAL ENROLLMENT REMAINS ABOVE 100 STUDENTS
 .
- A **KEY FACTOR** IN THIS DYNAMIC IS THE **HIGH QUALITY OF K-8 EDUCATION AND PREPARATION** THAT HOLMDEL STUDENTS RECEIVE, MAKING THEM **HIGHLY COMPETITIVE** FOR ADMISSION.

SCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS EXPENDITURES



• THE TOTAL ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT BUDGET IS APPROXIMATELY \$875,000, WHICH REPRESENTS ABOUT 1.25% OF THE TOTAL SCHOOL DISTRICT BUDGET. LAST YEAR, AT THE HIGH SCHOOL ALONE, PARTICIPATION IN ATHLETICS WAS SIGNIFICANT:

FALL ~ 41% PARTICIPATION RATE WINTER ~ 20% PARTICIPATION RATE SPRING ~ 32% PARTICIPATION RATE

- THERE ARE INVALUABLE BENEFITS OF SCHOLASTIC ATHLETICS BEYOND DEVELOPING ATHLETIC SKILLS, THESE PROGRAMS PROMOTE PHYSICAL FITNESS, TEAMWORK, COLLABORATION, PROBLEM-SOLVING, AND SPORTSMANSHIP. THEY ALSO SERVE AS A SOURCE OF SELF-ESTEEM, CHARACTER BUILDING, AND RESILIENCE, TEACHING STUDENTS HOW TO HANDLE BOTH SUCCESS AND DEFEAT WITH GRACE. LIKE OUR PERFORMING ARTS PROGRAMS, ATHLETICS PLAY A CRUCIAL ROLE IN CREATING A WELL-ROUNDED SCHOOL EXPERIENCE.
- RESEARCH IS CLEAR THAT STUDENTS WHO ENGAGE IN AT LEAST ONE EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITY, WHETHER ATHLETIC OR OTHERWISE, TEND TO BE MORE SUCCESSFUL—NOT ONLY ACADEMICALLY BUT ALSO SOCIALLY AND EMOTIONALLY. (WACHSMUTH. S, LEWIS, T., & GAGE, A., 2023)
